Next steps and priorities for iConsiliu

- Digital notary services (public consultations, MSRP/USAID, EBRD, UK GGF, IFC, Sweden)
- eComerce Package (in process, EBRD, UK GGF, IFC, Sweden and MSRP&FTA/USAID)
- Study and recommendations on the inclusion of the Universal Postal Operator in the international eCommerce circuit (in process, EBRD, UK GGF, IFC, Sweden)
- Study and recommendations on consolidating the Fintech sector and digitizing SMEs (in process, EBRD, UK GGF, IFC, Sweden)
- The roadmap for digitizing the economy was developed in a joint effort by the Ministry of Economy, the Economic Council and development partners, and was approved in July 2020 and updated in July 2021. The roadmap has become the work agenda of the Advisory Council for the Digitization of the Economy, and it is necessary to monitor progress in implementation and update it regularly.

"Guillotine" Working Group






